Water is present everywhere in Hamburg and its proximity to the sea is noticeable throughout the city but nowhere is it as exciting and immediate as in the port: the gateway to the world gives off the distinctive scent of freedom, adventure and faraway lands. Seagulls circle in the stiff breeze. There's a hive of activity everywhere from the jetties to the container port as modern cruise ships glide past here just like freighters from all over the world, historical

sailing boats and nimble launches.



SPEICHERSTADT

HISTORICAL AND **FASCINATING**

Massive redbrick Gothic and winding canals: the historical Speicherstadt warehouse district isn't just a Hamburg landmark but also an architectural head-turner and picturesque idyll in the immediate vicinity of the busy international port. The world's largest connected warehouse district, which is more than one hundred years old, still houses valuable commodities today, from coffee, spices and tobacco to the world's largest Oriental carpet warehouse. This architectural highlight has been Hamburg's first UN-ESCO World Heritage Site since 2015.




