## SPEICHERSTADT HISTORICAL AND FASCINATING

Massive redbrick Gothic and winding canals: the historical Speicherstadt warehouse district isn't just a Hamburg landmark but also an architectural head-turner and picturesque idyll in the immediate vicinity of the busy international port. The world's largest connected warehouse district, which is more than one hundred years old, still houses valuable commodities today, from coffee, spices and tobacco to the world's largest Oriental carpet warehouse. This architectural highlight has been Hamburg's first UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2015.

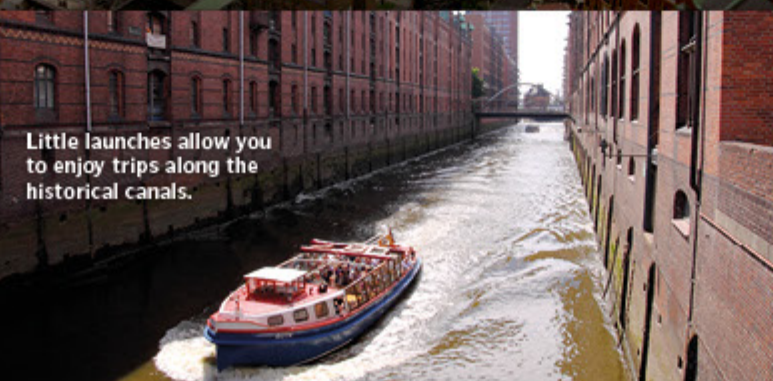

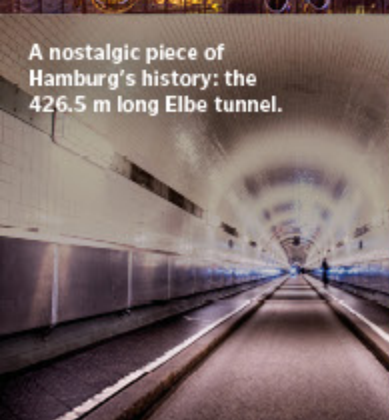

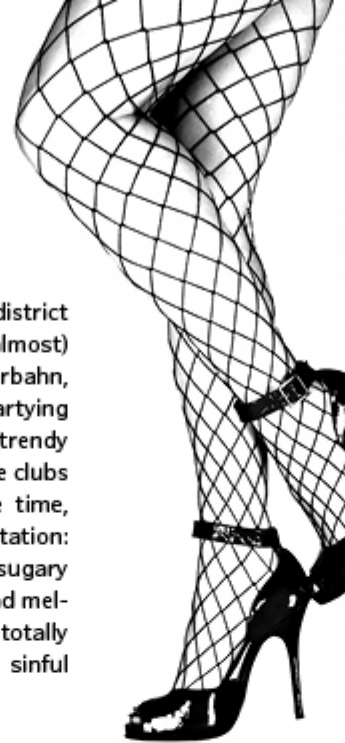

## ST. PAULI EXCITING AND ECCENTRIC

Hamburg's most flamboyant city district is all sorts but never boring and (almost) anything is possible on the Reeperbahn, not just at half twelve at night. Partying is almost a must on the Kiez – in trendy bars and rustic pubs, classic dance clubs and hip live clubs. At the same time, St. Pauli is just one big temptation: sometimes decadent, garish and sugary sweet, sometimes soul-stirring and melancholic but always surprising, totally irresistible with a sprinkling of sinful sights on every hot corner.

**15 Reeperbahn:** The world's most famous mile is a must during any visit to Hamburg. An intoxicating rush of Astra beer, currywurst sausage and neon signs. **16 Schmidts Tivoli:** An original theatre showing the only real St. Pauli musical "Heiße Ecke". **17 Panoptikum:** Germany's oldest waxworks museum. **18 Große Freiheit 36:** Music events venue with cult status. Live rock music, wild parties and dancing until you drop. **19 Hans-Albers-Platz:** One of the centres in St. Pauli – loud, packed and surrounded by pubs, bars and dives. **20 Park Fiction:** An urban oasis with artificial palm trees and a stunning view over the park. **21 Davidwache:** Probably Germany's most famous police station with Europe's smallest beat (92 hectares).

**Kunstmeile Hamburg:** Collection of renowned art institutions including the **22** Hamburger Kunsthalle, **23** Deichtorhallen and **24** Bucerius Kunst Forum. **25 Musicals:** Alongside New York and London, Hamburg is the world's third largest metropolis for musicals – with constantly changing shows. **26 Automuseum Prototyp:** A journey through the pioneering era of automotive engineering. **Stages:** Artistic variety from music to theatre and readings, e.g. at the **27** Schauspielhaus, **28** State Opera, **29** Thalia Theater or **30** Laeiszhalle. **Historical monuments,** e.g. **31** the town hall and **32** Chilehaus, which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. **33 Deichstraße:** The last preserved ensemble of the city's old villas that belonged to Hamburg's wealthy citizens. **34 Komponistenquartier:** A listed museum district dedicated to Hamburg's world-famous composers.
